- Can you pick up my pet from my vet or animal hospital?
- How will my pet be transported to your facility?
- How and where is my pet kept until they are cremated?
- How do I know that I am only getting my pet's remains back?
- What kind of container will my pet's remains be placed in if I decide not to purchase an urn?
- How long does it take from the time my pet is picked up until we can pick up the cremated remains?
- Besides the cremation, what else is provided with your cremation services?

Here are some other things to consider when pre-planning for your pet:

- Will you want a keepsake such as a paw print or nose print impression?
- Will you want to have a Memorial Service in our private memorial room?
- Is there a favorite toy or blanket you wish to be cremated with your pet?
- Will you want to keep or scatter your pet's remains?
- Would you want keepsakes, such as special jewelry?
- Personalized inscription on the Urn, and/or Memorial stone?
- Would you want a Personalized Memorial Chest to keep all your pet's memory items in for safekeeping?
- If you create a life celebration event, a few things you might include: guests you would like to attend, music, DVD, pictures, poems, etc.
